Dear Parents and Guardians:

As winter approaches, we would like to send a reminder of our official school dress code. Students are expected to be dressed and groomed in a manner which will not distract, interfere, or disrupt the educational program. Students are expected to present themselves in a neat, clean, and professional manner at all times. Therefore, proper school uniforms are expected to be worn every day and should not deviate from the style and color choices.

Please review the following with your child:

Top

- Solid color; navy blue, white, or light blue.

Sweater

- Must be solid navy blue. Hoodies not permitted.

Bottom

- Solid navy blue or khaki.

Shoes

- Dark colored securely fitting shoes.
- Dark or lightly colored sneakers
- Boots are permitted, but must be changed into shoes or sneakers upon arrival at school.

Hair and Make-Up

- Excessive or distracting makeup or hair color is not permitted. Hair color must be a naturally occurring color/shade in the human genome. Other hair colors such as purple, pink, green, orange, etc. are considered distracting.

Head wear

- Hats, caps, bandanas, doo-rags, curlers, and hair nets are not permitted.

We believe that school uniforms promote a sense of pride in our school and solidarity between students. And while the school may designate non-uniform days, such decisions will be made by the principal.
