School choice is a term given to a wide array of programs offering students and their families alternatives to publicly provided schools, to which students are assigned by the location of their family residence.

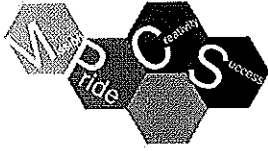

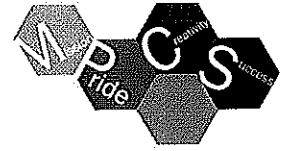
