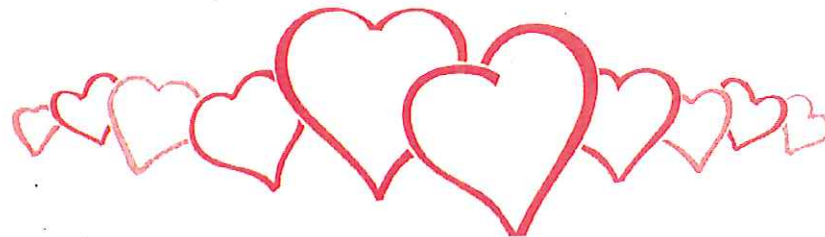

Dear Parents and Guardians,

New Jersey is participating in the Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers (PARCC) assessment that is designed to measure the New Jersey learning standards. PARCC has replaced the NJ ASK test. The tests will measure students' content knowledge and key skills, such as their ability to think critically, solve problems, and use information from their reading material to write well-developed essays.

New Jersey adopted new academic learning standards known as the Common Core State Standards in English Language Arts and Mathematics over the last three years to put all students on a stronger pathway to college and career readiness. To measure progress against those learning standards the new PARCC testing program was designed. PARCC will offer rich, performance-based tasks that will provide us with a better measure of our children's ability to write, think critically, and apply what they know. PARCC will also provide clearer signals to educators and parents about students' readiness for the next grade level and, in high school, for college and career.

The administration windows for the PARCC tests are as follows:

Assessment Grades	2016 Administration dates
Grades 5 and 6	April 18 to 29
Grades 3 and 4	May 2 to 13

Please pay close attention to the grade level and dates in which your child/ren are testing to ensure their presence at school and that they get adequate rest and a nutritious breakfast on those days.
